

### ACT Cap N1 LFN 2004


Regulate and control the manufacture, importation, exportation, distribution, advertisement, sale and use of Regulated Products namely:

Food, Drugs, Cosmetics, Medical Devices, Packaged Water, Chemicals and Detergents

# Counterfeit and Fake Drugs Unwholesome processed Foods (Miscellaneous Provision) Act Cap. C. 34 LFN 2004.

This law prohibits the sale of counterfeit, fake drugs and unwholesome processed foods. The Law also prohibits the sale and distribution of counterfeit, adulterated, banned, substandard or expired drugs.

#### Food and Drug Act Cap F. 32 LFN

This law is promulgated to prohibit the sale of certain foods, drugs, cosmetics and devices. The Law also regulates the manufacture, sale and advertisement of food, drugs, cosmetic and medical devices.

#### Food, Drug and Related Products (Registration) Act Cap F.33

The Law is promulgated to prohibit the manufacture, sale, distribution, advertisement, importation, exportation, sale or distribution of regulated products

# Policies Targeted at Enhancing Local Manufacturing

| S/N | POLICY  | PURPOSE  |
|-----|---|--|
| 1   | The 5 + 5 Policy  | Aimed at migration of previously imported products to local manufacturing after two rounds of registration   |
| 2   | NAFDAC's Ceiling List                                   | To reduce importation of medicines that can be manufactured locally (currently 36 products are on the list)  |
| 3   | New Policy on Establishment of Pharma Plants In Nigeria | Enables existing and intending FPP manufacturers to obtain regulatory approval of their facility design right before retrofitting or erection of new pharma plants |
| 4   | Presidential Executive Order                            | Increasing local production of healthcare products, reducing costs of healthcare equipment and consumables, and promoting local investments.                       |
| 5   | Periodic Stakeholders Collaboration                     | Through periodic engagements, issuance of notes to industry, regulatory meetings etc.  |
